INFORMATION

- 1. Prices and dates are subject to change without notice.
- 2. Reservations for 2022 bookings will commence January 1, 2022.
- 3. Cheques must be made payable to "Area 3 Promotional Club". Please do not send cash through the mail. Email transfer payments for any Area 3 form can be sent to: wlove@sympatico.ca. Please notify Val of exactly what payment is for and the security question answer in a separate email.
- 4. No reservations considered booked until paid in full. Stalls must be purchased as a complete single unit. **Reservation full payment deadlines** (late fees apply after these dates):

Spring Classic – April 1, 2022 | Summerama – May 31, 2022 | Summer Circuit – July 1, 2022

- 5. Phone or email reservations made prior to the full payment deadlines are acceptable. However, if payment is not received within 10 business days of the reservation request, **the stalls will be released.**
- 6. Stall reservations received after the payment deadlines will be subject to late fee noted in booking form and must be paid in full two weeks prior to the show. All late reservations must be paid by e-transfer.
- 7. Choice of preferred stall locations will be given <u>first</u> to paid sponsors (sponsor funds must be received prior to above deadlines and over the Gold level of \$300), then assigned on a "first paid, first served" basis.
- 8. **GROUP STALL REQUESTS** Those wishing to stall together your bookings MUST be received together. While every effort will be made to comply with specific stall grouping requests, show management reserves the right to assign stall locations pursuant to available space.
- 9. **SHAVINGS** exhibitors are encouraged to pre-order shavings on the stall booking forms not only is this service less expensive, it also means your shavings will be at your stalls upon arrival at the show! For those exhibitors who need shavings delivered when you arrive on the grounds, please note that they will only be available at designated times that the facility sets. During the show, shavings are available through the show office (designated times)
- 10. MOVE IN TIMES please refer to the show page on our website for details on move in times for each show.
- 11. All horses that stay on the grounds overnight MUST have a prepaid stall. Horses that ship in for the day and do not have a prepaid stall are <u>not</u> permitted to use a stall for stabling, storing tack or tie a horse to it. On occasion there may be stalls available for day use at the full weekend price and must be paid for at the show office on the same day of the ship in check with show office on arrival.
- 12. All DOGS must be on a leash LEX will have animal control patrolling the show
- 13. Noise by-laws for Lindsay have an 11 pm curfew please be respectful to your fellow campers and exhibitors.

CANCELLATION/REFUND POLICY

- Stall cancellations received prior to the reservation payment dates noted above will receive a full refund minus \$10 admin fee.
- Cancellations received within 2 weeks of the show will NOT receive a refund under any circumstance for any part of their booking (Stall, Camping, Hydro etc).
- A \$50 administration fee will apply to all NSF or returned cheques. If an account is not cleared within 15 business
 days: All reservations will be released and reassigned. Cash only will be required for all remaining Area 3 shows
 for the current year. NSF or returned cheque repeat offenses will result in the suspension of all Area 3 member
 privileges, a letter to OQHA & AQHA and "cash-only" status for life.

All-In One Fee – includes one horse stall, all AQHA entries for that one horse for all exhibitors, all office fees, all drug fees. All In One fee for the Summer Circuit does not include Rookie/Level 1 show on August 19.

NSBA All-In Fee – includes NSBA entry fees for one horse in any NSBA Class

Trail Fee – All horses who are showing in the Trail will pay a \$20 fee (per horse for entire circuit total) to cover costs of equipment, maintenance, course set up and design.

Early Stall – discounted fee for stalls booked prior to deadline

Tack Stall – please indicate number of tack stalls required within booking form

Stall – regular price for stall after early discount deadline

Early Arrival - \$20 per horse fee for arriving on show grounds 2 days prior first show day. **MUST** be paid in advance and show organizers **MUST** know what horses are arriving prior to show.

Shavings – pre ordered shavings delivered to stalls in advance of arrival at \$9 per bag. During show shavings will have restricted delivery times at \$10 per bag.

Area 3 is pleased to announce that we will continue to offer exhibitors the "ALL IN ONE FEE" at all 3 shows for 2022.

PREMISE AND PROCESS

The "Early ALL IN ONE FEE" is an opportunity for exhibitors to pay one fee to cover their stall, entry fees, and all related administration fees. By paying the "Early ALL IN ONE FEE" a horse can be shown in any division by a combination of riders for one low fee at a considerable discount for exhibitors who are comfortable paying in advance of the show!

For Example

Back number 1234 is entered in Novice Youth Showmanship (with Exhibitor A), Novice Youth Trail (with Exhibitor A), Youth Performance Halter (with Exhibitor B), Novice Amateur Trail (with Exhibitor C), Open Western Riding (with Exhibitor D) and Green Western Pleasure (with Exhibitor D). The ALL IN ONE FEE would include the stall fee, the 6 entry fees and the related administration fees.

Advantages

Another advantage to the ALL IN ONE FEE is that if a rider decides to enter additional classes on the day of the show, the additional classes would be added to the show bill at no extra cost.

RULES FOR EARLY ALL IN ONE FEE

- 1) MUST show in one Halter class (any division) OR one OPEN PERFORMANCE CLASS per show
- 2) <u>MUST PAY IN FULL PRIOR TO THE DEADLINES FOR THE ALL IN ONE FEE</u> (payment on stall booking form must also denote the AQHA registered name of horse and the back number to which the All In One Fee applies):

SPRING CLASSIC \$457 BEFORE APRIL 1 | SUMMERAMA \$457 BEFORE MAY 31 | SUMMER CIRCUIT \$457 BEFORE JULY 1

- 3) <u>ABSOLULTELY NO REFUNDS FOR ANY PART OF THE ALL IN ONE FEE</u> for cancellations received within 2 weeks of the show date. A 25% administration fee is applicable to all refunds prior to that date.
- 4) NSBA classes do not qualify for the ALL IN ONE FEE. Separate fee for NSBA All-In
- 5) The Rookie/Level 1 Show is not included in the Summer Circuit All-In One Fee.

Type	Description
SINGLE	A Single membership allows you to accumulate Area 3 points in open classes only. An additional fee is required to accumulate Youth or Amateur points.
FAMILY	A Family membership includes Husband and Wife and all children 18 years of age and under residing at the same address. All members in a Family are able to accumulate Area 3 points in open classes only. An additional fee is required to accumulate Youth or Amateur points.
AMATEUR	This additional fee is required to accumulate any Amateur points once a Single or Family membership has been established.
YOUTH	This additional fee is required to accumulate any Youth points once a Single or Family membership has been established. Youth must be 18 or under as of January 1st 2020.

Membership Reminder

In order to accumulate points for Area 3 year-end awards, all riders, handlers and owners (including those in partnerships) must be members of Area 3 and reside within the boundaries of Area 3 (as outlined by the Ontario Quarter Horse Association rules). Applications from inactive Area clubs bordering Area 3 (Area 4, Area 6 & 7 only) are to be completed and submitted. Area 3 Board of Directors reserves the right to review and accept at their discretion.

It is the members' responsibility to ensure that you have a current membership; that you are compliant to the necessary membership criteria and have familiarized yourself with the Area 3 Point & Trophy Rules regarding accumulating points towards year end awards. For full details consult the current Point and Trophy rules on the Area 3 website – www.area3.ca

Please ensure that you have a valid membership - mailing your form in alone isn't sufficient and your points will not start accumulating until you have paid your membership in full.

The Ontario Quarter Horse Association sets out the Area boundaries as follows:

Area 3: The central west part of Ontario – bordered on the west by Hwy 6; on the north by Georgian Bay and the northern Muskoka county line; on the east by Hwy 11 north and Hwy 12 south and on the south by Lake Ontario.

Area 4: The central east part of Ontario – bordered on the west by Hwy 11 north and Hwy 12 south; on the north by the northern Muskoka/Haliburton/Hastings/Renfrew county lines; on the east by Hwy 41 and Lennox & Addington County; and on the south by Lake Ontario.

Area 5: The eastern part of Ontario – bordered on the west by Hwy 41 and Lennox & Addington County; on the north by the northern Renfrew county lines; on the east by the Ottawa River; and on the south by Lake Ontario and the St. Lawrence Seaway.

Area 6: The north-western part of Ontario – bordered on the west by Manitoba; on the north by Hudson Bay; on the east by the 86° of longitude and on the south by Lake Superior.

Area 7: The north-eastern part of Ontario – bordered on the west by the 86° of longitude; on the north by Hudson Bay; on the east by Quebec and on the south by Lake Superior and Michigan
